NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1** The Falcon Cup regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The prescriptions of the Canadian national authority, Sail Canada, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1** The Falcon Cup is an invitational regatta and invitees will be at the sole discretion of FBYC. There will be one flying sail boat (FS) and one non flying sail boat (NFS) from each club. The FS boat will have a PHRF rating between 105 and 135. The NFS boat will have a PHRF rating between 168 and 186. FBYC must be advised of selected boats by July 1st, 2019.
- 2.2** Selected boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, proof of valid insurance and a valid PHRF-LO certificate to Alan May, PH5 - 712 Rossland Road East, Whitby, ON L1N9E8 or presenting it at the registration table. Cheques should be payable to FBYC.
- 2.3** Professional crew will be limited to one per boat.

3 FEES

The fee to register for the regatta is \$80. (\$70.80 plus GST)

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1** Registration shall be on Friday August 9th from 1800hrs to 2000hrs. The Skipper's meeting will be held at 0915 hrs on Saturday, August 10th.
- 4.2** Course racing will be held on Saturday August 10th and on Sunday August 11th. A maximum of three races will be held on Saturday and two on Sunday. Length of races will be determined by wind conditions at the time.
- 4.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday August 10th shall be 1100hrs. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday August 11th shall be 1030hrs
- 4.4** No race shall start after 1600hrs on Saturday August 10th; no race shall start after 1300hrs on Sunday August 11th.

5 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF - LO certificate.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing Instructions will be available online at www.fbyc.ca.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be posted on the committee boat as described in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 The completion of at least one race will constitute a series.

8.2 If five races are completed there will be one drop race.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive any form of electronic communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. The committee boat will monitor the CDN VHF Channel announced at the Skipper's Meeting. Race Committee broadcasts regarding its intentions, the course to be sailed, start times, course changes etc. are a courtesy only. Failure of the Race Committee to make a broadcast, the timing of a broadcast, or the failure of a boat to hear a broadcast shall not be grounds for redress. This amends rule 60.1(b).

10 PRIZES

Prizes and awards will be given on Sunday August 11th, 2019 after the final races are complete and the scores are tabulated. This will be no later than 1530hrs.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance, and provide a copy of that information to FBYC.
